



CEMforSMEs: a brand new set of tools for the Management of Circular Economy practices in the Small and Medium Enterprises in the Agrifood Sector.

The project CEMforSMEs is an inspiring initiative led by a visionary organization, LOBA from Portugal, setting the base, together with 6 partners from 5 more EU countries (Italy, Spain, Belgium, Greece and Cyprus), to support the development of managers of SMEs with competences related to circular economy, and therefore developing the job profile of the CEM (Circular Economy Manager) for Small and Medium Enterprises of the Agrifood Sector in the Vocational Education and Training.

Throughout 2 years of work, the partnership has managed to develop an impressive number of tools and materials, including the framework, profile and curriculum of the Circular Economy Manager, a dedicated training course and learning platform, a set of online educational mini-games accessible through an App, and a Policy Handbook.

All of the mentioned results have been developed by the work of the partners and designed and validated thanks to their research and the support of professionals and entrepreneurs from the agrifood sector, VET learners and educators, and other experts from various linked fields.
